SUMMER YOUTH INTERN

The Summer Youth Intern shall work within the context of Thrive Student Ministries at First United Methodist Church of Angleton Texas, so as to help with the guiding, teaching, spiritual development and direction of the youth from 6th grade to recently graduated high school seniors. The Summer Youth Intern shall serve under the direction and coordination of the Co-Youth Directors, in concert with the entire church staff. The Summer Youth Intern will assist in multiple levels of participation in the leadership of the ministry to and with youth and their families.

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS: The Youth Intern shall be a high school graduate and currently enrolled in a degree program at a college or university.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. As part of the youth staff, meet bi-monthly with Co-Youth Directors and Youth Council for assignments and planning which will include:
 - a. Attending and occasionally teaching the youth Sunday school class
 - b. Help with games and general youth group supervision
 - c. Planning and organization of weekly "WOW" activities
 - d. Creating and sharing devotional talks for "WOW" activities
 - e. Planning and organization of the summer kick-off lock-in
 - f. Planning and organization of the end-of-summer retreat
 - g. Help assimilate new youth into group, especially recent Confirmands

2. Multiple-day trips and activities:
 - a. Vacation Bible School
 - b. Lakeview Summer Camp
 - c. UM ARMY and/or Faith In Action
 - d. End-of-summer retreat

3. Optional and related duties as available:

- a. Desktop publishing of calendars, newsletters, event flyers, forms, etc.
- b. Contact visitors and invite to programs
- c. Phone and volunteer recruitment as needed
- d. Solicit car drivers as needed
- e. Assist with worship compilation

The Summer Youth Intern reports to the Co-Youth Directors and the Senior Pastor and ultimately to the Staff-Parish Relations Committee.
